BIOGRAPHIE

Horst Hippler is President of the German Rectors' Conference (Hochschulrektoren-konferenz – HRK) since May 2012. The HRK is the umbrella organisation of German universities and universities of applied sciences. Currently, the HRK has 268 member institutions.

From 1993 to 2012 he was Professor of Physical Chemistry at the University of Karlsruhe, today Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT). From 2002 Horst Hippler served first as Rector of the University of Karlsruhe and from 2009 to 2012 as President of the KIT.

Horst Hippler is a member of various advisory and supervisory bodies of German and French universities, of Tomsk Polytechnic University as well as the Conseil Scientifique d'Electricité des France (EDF). He is a member of acatech, the German Academy of Science and Engineering, and a corresponding member of the Goettingen Academy of Sciences. He has been awarded honorary doctorates by the École nationale supérieure d'arts et métiers (ENSAM) in the university association ParisTech and by the University of Strasbourg.
